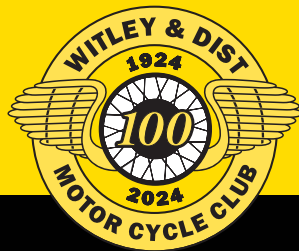

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

VENUE

Welsh Drive, Warren Heath, Hampshire RG27 0QB

What3Words: Entrance: ///tent.vivid.motorist • Event HQ: ///instructs.prove.chainsaw

Strictly no machines or vehicles to be ridden or driven outside of competition at the venue.

This includes pit bikes/mini bikes/scooters or quads. No trade stands without prior permission.

PARKING/ACCOMMODATION

All attendees must park where directed by officials.

INSURANCE

The insurance cover for this event will be BASIC (limit of liability £40 Million) and Medical Malpractice Insurance (limit of liability £5 Million) is included. **Competitors are strongly recommended to purchase their own personal accident cover.**

SIGNING ON

All competitors must sign on **between 0800 and 0930** before presenting their machine to Technical Control. You will be issued pre-printed rider numbers that must be clearly displayed on your machine, unaltered.

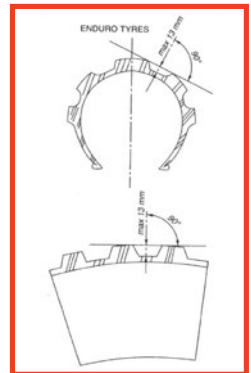
MACHINE EXAMINATION

Competitors must present their machines for examination **between 0800 and 0930**. **All motorcycles must be fitted with enduro tyres to FIM/ACU specification – SEE BELOW FOR DETAILS.** Riders must also present their helmet with the correct ACU stamp, and an environmental mat, which must be used when refuelling. Noise testing may take place and the Clerk of the Course reserves the right to exclude any machine he deems excessively noisy.

ESR9 TYRES NB PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Front and rear – Unless otherwise stated in the Enduro Sub Event Regulations and event Supplementary Regulations, tyres must be 'Enduro' type to current FIM specification with DOT or E mark imprinted (see diagram at the end of Enduro Section).

NOTE: Some motocross tyres do not comply with Road Traffic Act Regulations and are not permitted for events using the Public Highway. Only tyres which appear on the tyre manufacturer's range catalogue or tyre specification list as suitable for use on the Public Highway for the motorcycle entered, may be used. They may be of Trial, Trail or Enduro pattern with a depth of tread not more than 13mm at the time of manufacture.



IMPORTANT! PLEASE READ CAREFULLY



HOLDING AREA

There is no Parc Fermé at the event, and riders should place their machines in start order following technical control, following the instructions of officials.

START

1000 on Sunday 9th February. Riders will start in number order, departing four riders per minute. Please refer to the riders' list or your envelope, issued at signing on, for your individual start time.

ROUTE

The route is approximately 18 miles of varied forestry going. This includes mixed woodland, natural valleys, disused pits, flinty climbs, hills and brash areas. Riders should be mindful of the nature of endurance competition and take care on the first lap especially.

SPECIAL TESTS

There is two special tests which will be ridden untimed on the first lap. **Spectators must only spectate from approved areas and be mindful of the dangers presented by motorsport.**

REFUELLING

Must only take place in the designated areas on an environmental mat. **Smoking is prohibited and any competitor working on or fuelling a bike not on an environmental mat will be DISQUALIFIED.**

BLUE TAPE AREAS

The refuelling point, approach to time controls and track crossings will be designated blue tape/walking pace areas. **The penalty for non-compliance is DISQUALIFICATION.**

FIRST AID

Will be provided by Team Medic. **Please report any incidents to event officials.**

IMPORTANT NOTICES

ROUTE MARKING



Directional arrow – follow the route ahead



Single turn arrow – turning in 50m



Twin turn arrow – turn immediately



Gated arrows – pass between the arrows



Crossed arrows – danger/hazard



Tape – pass through the taped section

DISQUALIFICATIONS

- Not riding at walking pace in the **BLUE** tape area
- Smoking in the refuelling area (*including* E-cigarettes)
- Refuelling outside designated area or not on environmental mat
- Not keeping to the course / course cutting
- Irregularities in lap times recorded suggesting course cutting
- Failure to keep any support crewmember out of prohibited areas

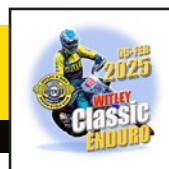

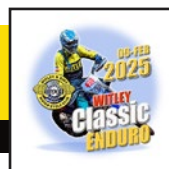

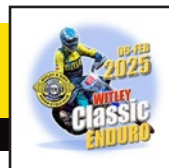

WHERE IT ALL BEGAN

Way back in 1921, a small band of motorcycle enthusiasts used to gather in the yard of Mullards the Builders in Witley. Without doubt, the friendship, the conversation and banter would have been much the same as when motorcyclists get together today.

Numbers slowly increased and a club was formed. By now, many wanted to take part in the Trials and Hill Climbs which were becoming very popular at the time, so the decision was made in

1924 to affiliate to the Auto Cycle Union, and be officially recognised as a Motorcycle Club.

As the number of clubs affiliated to the ACU grew, it was decided to break them down into regions, each region forming itself into a 'Centre'. The region consisting of Kent, Surrey and Sussex, together with the southern half of London, became the South East Centre and has remained so until this day. It was in 1926 that the Witley Club became affiliated to the ACU South East Centre.

Witley MCC has always played a major role, not only in our contribution to the management of the Centre, especially in the early days, but also in the quality of the events we have run and the competitors we have produced.

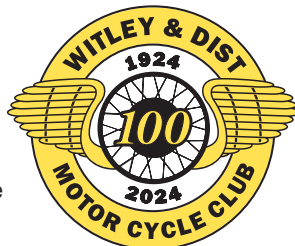

At present our members organise and take part in all types of Trials, Enduros, road runs and social events.

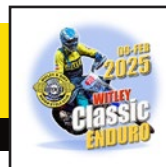

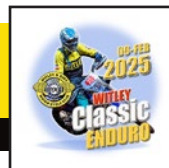

Spectator and Support Crew Safety Information

The safety of spectators and support crews attending enduros is our top priority. We therefore ask you to read the following which applies to any ACU Enduro event you may attend.

Please listen to the instructions of officials and marshals, they are there for your safety and we want to run the safest event possible.

For your own safety and the safety of others:

- Respect marshals and follow their instructions.
- Don't walk on the route/live track.
- Where provided, use designated spectator areas.
- Do not stand too close to the track, particularly on the outside of corners and the landing areas of jumps.
- If a marshal asks you to move to a safer position, please comply with their instructions.
- Remain alert at all times, remember some motorcycles, particularly electric, may not make much noise when approaching.
- Always allow a margin for error. Expect the unexpected.
- If you have to cross a live track, pick a crossing point/safe spot with good visibility and only cross when it is safe to do so.
- Only officials, competitors and authorised helpers (pit crews) are allowed in service and refuelling areas. No bicycles, e-bikes and e-scooters to be ridden in these areas.
- Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- Remember that alcohol and drugs can impair your responses and threaten your safety.

Spectators and support Crews who are asked to move but refuse to do so are putting their own safety and the safety of others at risk.

Where this happens, the Marshal has the authority to notify the Clerk of the Course, who will take appropriate actions to control the risk.

This may involve asking you to leave the event.
