Final Instructions!

<u>Please note the venue for the event:</u> Woodberry Lane, Rowlands Castle, Hants PO9 6DP. The entrance will be indicated from Woodberry Lane.

Please arrive from 0800. Race starts at 1100.

You **must** follow all parking instructions, this is essential for the parking to work.

Spectators are welcome to attend, provided you **park responsibly** and **follow the instructions of officials**. The start is at 1100.

Please do **not** bring your bikes to signing on. Bikes should be parked on the start line in your riding class. This will be a dead engine start with the opportunity to warm your engine beforehand.

Signing on will be from 0800. Please make a note of your number from the riders list before arriving at signing on. Transponders and numbers for your bike will be provided. There will be one wrist band transponder per team. You will need to swap this in the work area when changing riders.

If you are entering on the day, please:

Have exact change for payment: £50 entry, plus £20 for a day licence if you don't have a valid Enduro licence.

Any tyres are acceptable at this event.

There will be no scrutineering, but competitors are reminded that it is their responsibility to ensure their **bikes are in a safe condition** and that their **safety equipment is in good order**.

Servicing of machines **must** be carried out on a suitable environmental mat. Only **one mechanic per rider** will be allowed in the work area. **Strictly** no children, dogs or pushchairs.

Blue tape areas are **walking pace only**. These areas will be marshalled and **the penalty for ignoring this rule will be disqualification**. This rule is in place to ensure the safety of all those involved, taking part, marshalling and spectating.

Anyone seen course cutting will be excluded from the results.

Please enjoy the day and be kind and courteous to your fellow riders and organisers.
