#### ANNOUNCEMENT

The Witley and District Motor Cycle Club will host an open Hare and Hounds Enduro event for solo motorcycles: held under the National Sporting Code of the Auto-Cycle Union, the Enduro Standing Regulations (ESRs), these Supplementary Regulations and any Final Instructions that may be issued for the meeting.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

All riders must be members of a National Club and hold a current ACU/ SACU Licence and be a minimum age of 15 years. Any rider from another FMN (including Ireland) must produce a licence issued by their FMN together with start permission and proof of personal accident insurance including repatriation. One-day licences will be charged automatically on entry at a cost of £15 to any individual not holding a 2022 ACU Licence.

#### **INSURANCE**

The insurance cover for this event will be BASIC (limit of liability £10 Million) and Medical Malpractice Insurance (limit of liability £5 Million) is included. Competitors are strongly recommended to purchase their own personal accident cover.

#### VENUE

Brick Kiln Farm, Four Marks, Hampshire, GU34 5ET. Please follow the orange arrows up the track and park where directed by officials. Please note that there is strictly no overnight camping at the venue but there are plenty of local hotels.

#### FORMAT AND START TIME

The event format is a Hare and Hounds of three hours duration commencing at 1000. The start will be a Le Mans start from the firework explosion. As per ESR.27 there is no Parc Ferme at the event but riders are required to place their machines on the start grid by 0945. Failure to do so will incur a 20 second penalty.

#### ENTRIES ( Max. 180/200 )

Entries will through ACU Online at a cost of £50 (Solo) or £70 (Team) and allocated on receipt. Entry fees less an administration charge will only be refunded in the event of cancellation of the event or on receipt of a Doctor's certificate confirming incapacity. Entries open on 1<sup>st</sup> December at 0800 and close at 0800 on 20<sup>th</sup> December or when full. **No late or day entries will be accepted.** 

#### FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Final instructions will be published on the Witley MCC website and Facebook page.

#### TEAM EVENT

The team event is for two competitors, competing on either the same machine or two different machines (both of which will have been examined and numbered). Only one rider can compete on the course at any one time. The timing wristband must be transferred between riders in the paddock area ONLY. The combined time for both riders during the event distance will constitute the overall result. The number of laps that each rider individually completes is at the discretion of the team. The Team must have a name, entered into the ACU Online Entry System.

#### COURSE

This will be mixed motocross and woodland going, marked by tape and arrows. Viewing the special tests by any bicycle or mechanical/ electrical means is prohibited. Riders are reminded that blue tape areas are strictly walking pace and any deviation from the marked course will result in exclusion.

#### TIMING

Timing will be by electronic system and you will be provided a transponder at signing on in return for your ACU licence or a £20 deposit.

#### SIGNING ON

Competitors must sign on between 0800 and 0930 hrs before presenting their bike to technical control. You will be issued pre printed rider numbers that must be clearly displayed on your machine, unaltered.

#### MACHINE EXAMINATION

Competitors should present their machines for examination between 0800 – 1030. Tyres are free choice but FIM/ ACU enduro specification is recommended. Riders must also present their helmet with the correct ACU stamp, a fire extinguisher (min 2kg dry powder type) and an **environmental mat**, which must be used when refuelling. Noise testing may take place and the Clerk of the Course reserves the right to exclude any machine he deems excessively noisy. Strictly no pitbikes

#### MEDICATION

You may be asked to take part in a drugs test. It is your responsibility to declare at signing on if you are taking any drugs.

#### SECURITY

Competitors must be aware that the security of their machines and other property remains their responsibility at all times.

#### AWARDS

Will be made to the top three in each class (min six entries).

#### **CHILD PROTECTION**

The Secretary of the Meeting is the contact for all Child Protection matters.

#### **GENERAL**

The refuelling points, approach to the time control check, and some other areas will be marked with blue tape. Riders must adhere to walking pace and failure to comply with instructions at such points will incur immediate disqualification. The use of any form of mechanical vehicles other than event bikes is strictly prohibited.
